## ACCORDING TO TIME, MARICA BRANCHESI IS AMONG THE WORLD'S 100 MOST INFLUENTIAL PEOPLE IN 2018

There is the Italian researcher Marica Branchesi in TIME's annual list of the world's 100 most influential people. A new recognition, therefore, for the work done by Branchesi, researcher at GSSI, Gran

Sasso Science Institute, and INFN, with the historical observation of the collision of two neutron stars: an event that introduced a new way of studying our universe, opening the era of multi-messenger astronomy. As a member of the LIGO/VIRGO collaboration, Marica Branchesi's task was to coordinate the two scientific communities respectively observing gravitational waves and electromagnetic radiation. A coordination that has thus allowed the extraordinary scientific result of the first observation of an astrophysical cataclysm through different cosmic messengers: gravitational waves and photons.
